We would like to say thank you to governors Mr Moore and Mrs Pears as their 4 year terms of office as parent governors come to an end. These vacancies have been advertised and will go to ballot after the half-term break for parents to choose two new parent governors.

Class organisation for September 2016

We have worked very hard over the past 6 years to increase the intake of Shotley Bridge Primary School from 35 to 45 to 60. We persuaded DCC to build a 6th classroom onto the Benfieldside Road site in 2013 in order to raise our intake number and remove the need to teach mixed age classes in YR, Y1 and Y2. Work will shortly commence on an 8th classroom at the Snows Green Road site giving us room for two classes per year group across the whole school. Currently we are teaching YR to Y4 in two classes each as shown on the tables below.

At the end of Y4 we sadly lose a number of children to Corbridge Middle School which takes in children at Y5, 6, 7 and 8. This has historically been approximately 20 to 30% of our Y4 children. This impacts on our ability to have 2 classes of Y5 and Y6 children as numbers and funding for teaching

staff drop due to this drop in pupil numbers. Mrs Coombe has contacted Corbridge Middle School to ask how many pupils have applied for a place and we have been informed that the number is 11. Based on these figures our 55 Y4 children will become 44 Y5 in September 2016. I will contact Corbridge Middle School and the parents of all of our Y4 children in March when they will be in a position to inform us of exactly how many Y4 children we will lose. Once this number is established the Governing Body will be in a position to discuss how to organise and staff our school above Year 4. We will continue teaching YR to Y4 in two classes per year group and will endeavour to do the same with Y5 and ultimately Y6 if this is at all possible. We would strongly encourage parents of Y4 children to remain in Shotley Bridge Primary School where they have been for 5 out of 7 of their primary school years. We have faith in Consett Academy as an excellent school for our children to progress to but we recognise that some parents may wish for their children to attend the Northumberland system and ultimately, high school in Hexham. If this is the case then we encourage these parents to remain at Shotley Bridge Primary School and to join Corbridge Middle School at the start of Year 7. This is the norm for some Newcastle primary school children who remain at their school until the end of Y6 but then join one of the three Gosforth middle schools for Y7 and Y8. We will inform parents of class and staff organisation once we have more accurate figures in March.

Farewell to Mrs Storey

We wish Mrs Storey all the very best as she retires today from Shotley Bridge Primary School after 19 years. We will all miss her dearly. From all of the children, all of the staff and all of the parents past and present, good luck in the next chapter of your life Hilary.
