



Year 3 Curriculum Information

Autumn Term 2017

English

We are studying traditional tales, 'Stone Age Boy' and 'UG' this term. We will focus on recognising pronouns, prepositions and speech punctuation. We will send home a reading book and spellings each week for children to learn.

Maths

We will learn about numbers up to 1000 and use the four operations to solve problems and puzzles. We will begin to learn the four times table and find fractions of shapes and amounts.

PSHCE

We will be discussing and sharing what makes us so special, our gifts and talents and school council issues.

Science

This term, we will be studying Rocks and Soils. We are going to be classifying and testing different rocks, making fossils and looking at how soil is formed. We will learn how rocks and soil are used where we live.

History/Geography

In History, we will be studying the Stone Age. We will develop our chronological understanding of human history. We will examine evidence from the past and use this to make conclusions about what life must have been like.

PE

In PE, we will be doing Invasion Games. We are moving with the ball, using passing and receiving skills and invading the opposition. A coach will be in each week in the first half term doing multi-skills with the children. In the second half term the children will do dance in PE.

RE

This term, we will be studying Hinduism. We will look at Hindu ideas of God in many forms, the different characteristics of Ganesh, and the importance of the shrine in Hindu homes.

Computing

We will begin by learning about word processing, typing and being safe on the Internet. Following this we will use the programme 'Flowol'.

Art and Design

This term, we will be studying and creating portraits, cave paintings and stone age homes, using a variety of media.

Music

In Music, we will be using the programme 'Charanga' to study the different works of Bob Marley.
