English

This half term, we will be reading the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C.S Lewis. We will create a biography of an author, look at character profiles and produce newspaper reports from differing perspectives. After half term, we will start our class novel 'Freedom for Bron' by N.S Blackman' to link in to our history topic The Anglo-Saxons. In SPAG sessions we will focus on: expanded noun phrases, fronted adverbials, subordinating conjunctions, and pronouns.

Maths

We will be consolidating and mastering our skills learnt so far, with more reasoning, problem solving and practical application of problems. We will be using the formal written method to solve addition and subtraction problems with increasingly large numbers and up to two decimal places. We will increase in fluency with times tables up to 12×12 and apply these to solve multiplication and division problems. We will recognise and write equivalent fractions and calculate area and perimeter of a range of shapes.

PF

In P.E we will be focusing on striking and fielding. We will develop our fielding, bowling and striking skills. We will learn about positive team spirit. In the second half term, the children be focusing on athletics and we will practise a wide range of events.



Year 4 Curriculum Information

Summer Term 2018

History/Geography:

In History, the children will be taught about the life and culture of Anglo-Saxon Britain, including names, artefacts and village life. Linked to this topic, we will look at the geography of the UK, using OS maps and mapping the local area.

Science

This half term we will be investigating living things and habitats, investigating types of creatures in our environment and creating fact files to consolidate our learning. After half term, we move on to looking at how humans affect the environment.

PSHCE

We will be looking at the different groups that we belong to and discussing the changes that we may experience in life and how to cope with a variety of situations, before progressing on to 'being healthy'.

RE

We will be finding out more about what Christians believe about God. This will include the Genesis story, then the significance of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. We will explore religious symbols and the idea of God being infinite.

Computing

In computing, the children will learn about Rings of Responsibility and protecting personal information online. We will discuss cyber bullying and what to do in certain scenarios. After half term, we will learn how to create flow charts to carry out a variety of tasks.

Art and Design

We will be exploring industrial landscape artists such as Lowry. After this, we will create our own local landscapes of Consett and our school grounds. Linked to our history topic, the children will produce Anglo-Saxon brooches, creating prototypes and thinking about functionality and appearance.

Music

The children will learn to sing a wider range of songs of differing genre. They will continue to practise recorder and read music notation.
