

English

This term we are reading the 'The Great Chocoplot' by Chris Callaghan. As we read, we will infer how characters feel based on things that the characters say or do. We will compose a range of pieces of writing, some of which will be based around the story. In our writing, we are continuing to use a variety of conjunctions, accurately use inverted commas, use apostrophes for possession, understand and use the present perfect tense and begin to recognise subordinate clauses.

PSHCE

We will focus on individual worth and identifying positive things about ourselves and our peers. We will also learn how to resolve differences by looking at alternatives, making decisions and explaining choices.

Science

We will learn about the range of nutrients that humans need to consume in the correct amounts and the role that these nutrients play in keeping our bodies healthy. They will also learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement. When working scientifically, children will ask and answer their own questions about the human body and diet.



Year 3 Curriculum Information

Spring Term 2019

History/Geography

In Geography, we will be looking at different types of maps and when they are used. We will use and create different maps. We will deepen our knowledge of where we live in the world, improve our understanding of the U.K. and British Isles and begin to learn about some of the places in Europe.

PE

The children will be working with a coach in PE this term doing cricket. Additionally, the children will be doing dance where we will look at moving in time with the music and working together to create different movements in smaller groups.

Maths

We will solve a variety of addition and subtraction problems using money. We will practise reading the time to at least the nearest 5-minute interval. We will be continuing to practise the 3, 4 and 8 timetables and the division facts that go with them.

Computing

The children will look closely at being safe on a computer, including being safe on the internet. We look at word processing programs and how to use a search engine on the internet safely.

RE

Before the Easter Holidays, we will look at how and why Christians celebrate Easter, particularly Palm Sunday.

Art and Design

We will be focusing on Art this term, studying works of Art involving architecture, with a focus on perspective. In D&T we will be focusing on healthy eating to tie in with our Science unit and making our own smoothies.

Music

In Music, we will be learning to read musical notation on a staff and use glockenspiels to play a variety of songs.
