We are studying the 'Stone Age Boy' and the book 'UG' this term. We will focus on recognising pronouns, prepositions and speech punctuation. Children can change their reading book weekly and we will send home spellings each week for children to learn.

Maths

We will learn about numbers up to 1000 and use the four operations to solve problems and puzzles. We will begin to learn some of our times tables, focussing on the 3s, 4s and 8s.

Science

This term, we will be studying Rocks and Soils. We are going to be classifying and testing different rocks, making fossils and looking at how soil is formed. We will learn how rocks and soil are used where we live.



Year 3 Curriculum Information

Autumn Term 2019

History/Geography

In History, we will be studying the Stone Age. We will develop our chronological understanding of human history. In Geography, we will be developing our locational knowledge of the U.K. to include counties, major cities/towns and their physical features.

PE

In PE, we will be doing Invasion Games. We are moving with the ball, using passing and receiving skills and invading the opposition. In our dance lessons, we will be learning to perform a Diwali dance. In the second half of the term, we will focussing on gymnastics.

RE

This term, we will be studying Hinduism. We will look at Hindu ideas of God in many forms, the different characteristics of Ganesh, and the importance of the shrine in Hindu homes. We will also be looking at the festival of Diwali.

Computing

We will be looking at how to stay safe online. In the second half of the term, we will be using Microsoft word to develop our basic typing skills.
